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Southern Rhode Island Conservation District to host Morsel Dumplings public tasting and cooking demonstration

WESTERLY, Rhode Island, June 10, 2024 – The Southern Rhode Island Conservation District (SRICD) will host a product launch event for Morsel Dumplings on June 28 from 4 – 6:30 pm at Fresh Harvest Kitchen, 9 East Avenue, Unit F in Westerly. The event is free and open to the public and will feature a free dumpling tasting and cooking demonstration.

Morsel Dumplings are hand-formed and globally inspired dumplings – the dumpling is Chinese in its form and structure and the fillings are made from the highest quality ingredients sourced from local farms who humanely raise livestock free of hormones and no steroids and with no preservatives, additives or MSG.

The dough is made from scratch using premium King Arthur organic non-GMO flour. The following three varieties will be launched inspired by cuisines from Italy, Mexico and Turkey: pork and broccoli rabe, chicken salsa verde and spiced squash with walnuts and currants.

Notes Morsel Dumplings founder, entrepreneur and owner Terese Kung, “cooking and travel have always been a passion and constant in my life. Morsel Dumplings is the realization of a lifelong dream to blend the best of my culture with the joy of my extensive travels and food adventures. During the pandemic, I started experimenting with flavor profiles. When my friends started to ask for my dumplings, I realized my passion could potentially turn into something bigger than just a dinner party treat.”
